Main Operating Budget Hearings Begin

The House Finance Committee, Chaired by Rep. Jay Edwards, heard from several state agencies this week on the Governor's proposed main operating budget plan. The week began with testimony from OBM Director Kim Murnieks and LSC Director Wendy Zhan. Members also heard a panel of agency directors on Medicaid spending, the Ohio Department of Education and the Ohio Department of Higher Education, in addition to the Ohio Department of Transportation. Chairman Edwards plans to adopt a substitute bill by Friday, April 21st, an omnibus amendment by April 25th, and a full committee vote by the end of April. Committee testimony can be watched here.

Transportation Budget on the Fast-Track

The House Finance Subcommittee on Transportation heard testimony from Ohio Department of Transportation Director Jack Marchbanks, who reiterated his testimony given earlier this week before the full House Finance committee. The FY24-25 transportation budget seeks a 25% increase over the previous biennium due in part to billions of federal government dollars via the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law. Chairman Edwards plans to adopt a substitute bill on February 20th followed by an omnibus amendment later that week. His goal is to pass the full Transportation budget by Monday, February 27th.
